Jessie's Treat Recipe

2c. whole wheat flour

2 eggs

1/4c. peanut butter (Make sure it is not sweetened with xylitol. Xylitol is toxic, and causes liver failure in dogs)

1/2c. canned pumpkin or a peeled, boiled sweet potato Add water or broth if it's too dry

Mix all ingredients together. Roll dough into 1 ½ inch balls and smash with a fingertip onto a greased(coconut oil) cookie sheet.

Bake at 350 degrees in the oven for 25-30 min. Then turn the oven off and leave them in the oven overnight to dry out. The texture should be hard and crunchy, not soft.

In the story "JESSIE", Jessie tastes grapes from a vine. This was added to the story to show the setting and area where Jessie was found as a stray. It is not meant to encourage anyone to feed grapes or raisins to a dog. Both grapes and raisins are toxic to dogs. Not all dogs will have a negative reaction right away. Grapes and raisins, when fed to dogs, can lead to kidney damage. It may not affect your dog right away, but it is very dangerous for him or her to eat and can be harmful to his or her overall health. Never feed dogs grapes or raisins.
